Description:

Goals:

- Know the values, ethical and spiritual principles of the various religions
- Create spaces for dialogue and mutual knowledge
- Spread the culture of peace


Activity:

- Promote mutual understanding between people of different religions
- Present and propose the interreligious peace dice as an instrument of peace and spread its culture
- Take interest in each other's religious holidays, congratulating each other with a phone call, a card, a greeting via email or WhatsApp

It is an activity that can be done:

- On an individual level, with a classmate, co-worker, the person you meet every day at the bakery or supermarket, a family member or simply a neighbor
- Among different religious communities, promoting moments of coexistence, dialogue and exchange of testimonials on the living out of one's faith
