Peace Pals International Art Exhibition & Awards

Description

The activity is based on drawing peace-related pictures. Participants will submit their art creations to Peace Pals international Art Exhibition & Awards.

The activity is promoted by <u>Peace Pals International</u> and <u>Living Peace International</u>.

Target group

Children and kids from any school, association, or group.

Goals

- Spread the culture of peace
- Meditate on peace values while you improve your artistic skills

Activity

- Every year we have a new theme we can work on.
 Artworks can be painted or drawn by hand on paper or cardboard. Recommended size:
 5" x 7" inch
 12.7 x 17.7 cm
- In order not to be disqualified, every child or kid must create her artwork on her own. In addition, the words "May Peace Prevail On Earth" must be added on the artwork.
- We have four age categories. Every participant can submit one artwork only.
 Category One: 5 7 year olds
 Category Two: 8 10 year olds
 Category Three: 11 13 year olds
 Category Four: 14 16 year olds
- Those willing to take part in the exhibition <u>must register on the Peace Pal International website</u>. After registered, the participant will be given a link to his personal dashboard where she/he can upload his/her artwork. All artwork must be scanned in high resolution (300 DPI), saved as a JPG and follow the rules and guidelines.

The artworks can be submitted in two ways:

1. **Online**: accessing the User Login area on the personal dashboard (<u>http://wppspeacepals.org/user-login/</u>) and following the instructions.
