Target group

Children and young from 6 to 24 years old, from schools, associations and groups.

Goals

- Spread the culture of peace, interweaving new relationships and making new friends with people from all around the world
- Challenge and encourage kids to be leaders in building a culture of peace

Activity

Candidates for Young Ambassador of Peace will be indicated by their teachers or educators and must be recognized as "builders of peace" by their actions and words, fraternity and humanity demonstrated in their daily lives, at school, home, everywhere!

Candidate profile must include:

- Name and family name
- Age
- School/group/association name, address, and email address
- A candidate photograph
- Documents in support of the candidacy (you may include personal experiences concerning peace actions, or pictures or videos proving your commitment)
- A poetry or a message written by the candidate

All the candidate profiles will be forwarded to the headquarters of the Universal Circle of Ambassadors of Peace in Geneva (Switzerland) where the selection takes place.

The organizers will notify all of the concerned parties and send them the *Young Ambassadors of Peace* certificates.

Deadline

Young Ambassadors of Peace candidacy deadline:

South Hemisphere: 30 July

North Hemisphere: 31 December

Awarding of the Young Ambassadors of Peace certificate:

The Young Ambassadors of Peace certificate will be awarded by the teacher, group leader or any important person of your own choosing during a ceremony organized in your area, according to personal preferences.

Suggested dates:

- 21 September, concurrently to the International Day of Peace and the official beginning of the Living Peace International annual program.
- 30 January, concurrently to the School Day of Non-violence and Peace. ***
